Application Checklist

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED (Unless there is written notice from your advisor)

- A minimum **2.50 GPA** at Wayne State University or previous institution if a new transfer student and completion of a minimum of 53 semester hours of coursework.
- A passing score on each of the three sections of the MTTC Professional Readiness Exam (PRE) #96 (<http://www.mttc.nesinc.com>). A test score reported directly to Wayne State University is required. When registering for the PRE, please select Wayne State University (31) as a “College or University to Receive Scores”. *See advisor for accepting ACT and/or Michigan Merit Examination (MME) scores in lieu of the PRE.”*
If you are taking the PRE later than a week from the official application deadline there is no guarantee of your eligibility to attend an orientation.
- Transcripts: Please verify that all courses taken outside of WSU are reflected on your WSU transcript at the time of application. Only courses that have been evaluated by WSU will be reviewed at the point of application. If a course is complete but has yet to be processed by WSU, you must provide a paper copy of the passing grade from the other institutions transcript screen.
- Current Negative Tuberculosis (TB) test results within the past **three years (please provide verification)**.
- If there have been any substitutions made on your curriculum guide you must turn it in for review.
- Completion of Intermediate Composition (IC) course with a “C” or better.
(This requirement does not apply to Post-Bachelor Students)
- Provide Personal Statement: Instructions are part of the application packet.

- REQUIREMENTS SPECIFIC TO TEACHER CERTIFICATION MAJOR**

All majors require verification of 40 hours of Group work with Children: See instructions on Evaluation of Group Work page

 - **SECONDARY EDUCATION:** completion of a minimum of 12 semester hours in teaching major required.
 - **EARLY CHILDHOOD & ELEMENTARY EDUCATION:** A minimum of MAT 1110 must be completed.
 - **SPECIAL EDUCATION:** MAT 1110, PSY 1010/1020, PSY 2400, & one of the following: (BIO 1030/ BIO 1050/BIO 1510/SCE 5010) must be completed.
 - **FOREIGN LANGUAGE MAJORS/MINORS:** must contact an advisor upon completion of Foreign Language requirements to be granted permission to take the Oral Proficiency Exam (OPI).
 - **BILINGUAL/BICULTURAL EDUCATION (BBE)/ ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE MINORS:** must complete the Oral Proficiency Exam (OPI) and Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) prior to admission. Applications must include a signed BBE/ESL plan of work.
 - **VISUAL ARTS EDUCATION:** Completion of a minimum 30 credits of Art Foundation courses and the completed portfolio review form required.
 - **PHYSICAL EDUCATION MAJORS:** KIN 5100, 18 credit hours in the major, and MAT 1000 or Higher, or STA 1020.
 - **HEALTH EDUCATION:** 12 credit hours of Health coursework
 - **COMBINED DEGREE:** students must provide a signed plan of work from degree granting college.
- POST-BACHELORS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM APPLICANTS:** Submit a copy of College of Education transcript evaluation form.
