

Options for adding a 6-12 health endorsement

You must already have a secondary provisional or professional teaching certificate to exercise either of these two options. Both options require successful completion of the health MTTC (taken after the methods classes).

Option 1 – Post Bachelor’s Option:

Apply to WSU as a post bachelor student (undergrad). This is the cheapest option, however, nothing that you take under this status can be applied toward a graduate degree or earn graduate credit.
