Doctoral Dissertation: Prospectus and Record of Approval

The student must prepare a prospectus of the proposed dissertation research before preparing this form. The prospectus and outline must be approved before research is begun. No student will be permitted to register for more than seven (7) semester hours of Dissertation Research and Direction (ED 9989) before this form is signed by the Graduate Officer of the College.

Instructions

1. Attach a copy of your prospectus (dissertation proposal).
2. Obtain the signatures of the Dissertation Advisor and all Dissertation Committee Members.
3. Attach a copy of the Animal or Human Investigation Committee's Memorandum of Approval (if applicable). *All proposals involving animal and human investigation must first be submitted to the Animal (<http://iacuc.wayne.edu>) or Human (<http://www.hic.wayne.edu>) Investigation Committee for review and approval prior to beginning any research and prior to final approval by the Graduate Director of the College of Education.*
4. Submit all of the above documents to the Graduate Education Office (489, Education). Final approval resides with the Graduate Officer of the College of Education.

Please note: It is important to remember when selecting a research subject that dissertations are public documents, and publication and distribution will not be suppressed by Wayne State University.
